Those in attendance will include City Parish President, Joey Durel, as well as Director of Community Development Ben Berthelot, major contributors to the newly revised plan.

The AcA has been working with leaders of the city parish council for over a year in designing the new plan. If adopted, it will streamline funding for community organizations, allowing them to receive critical government support more efficiently.
