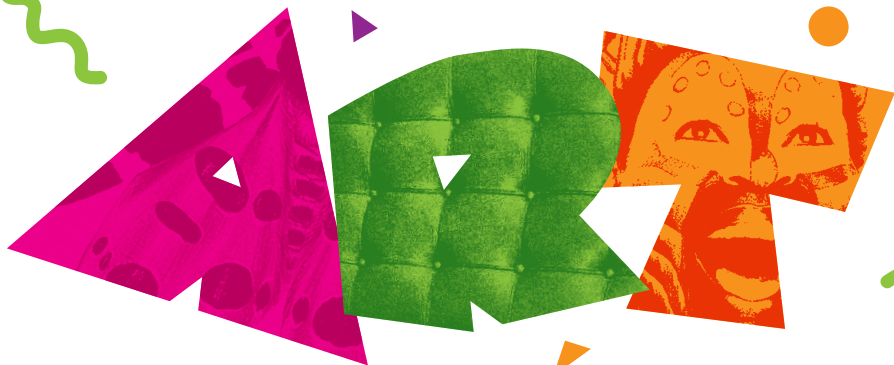

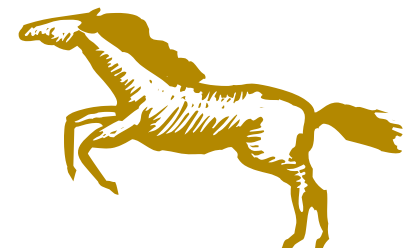

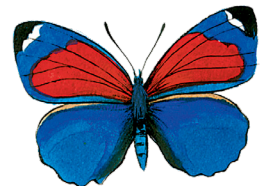

AGES 8–14

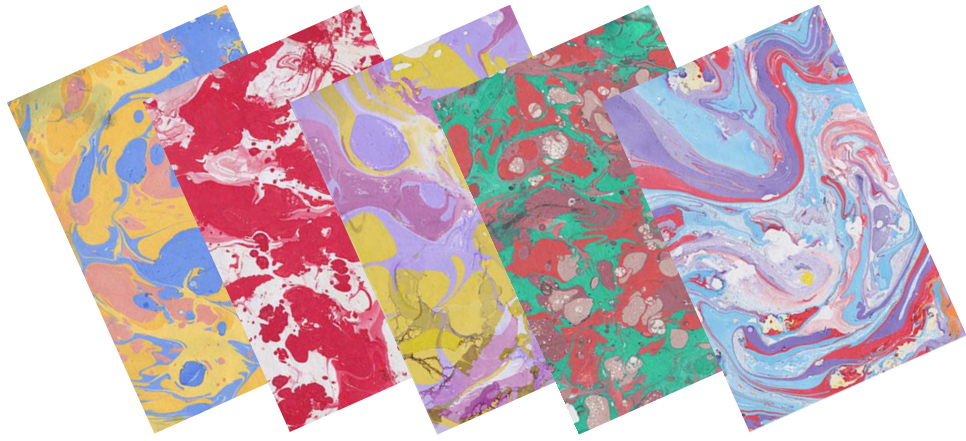

AGES 6–12

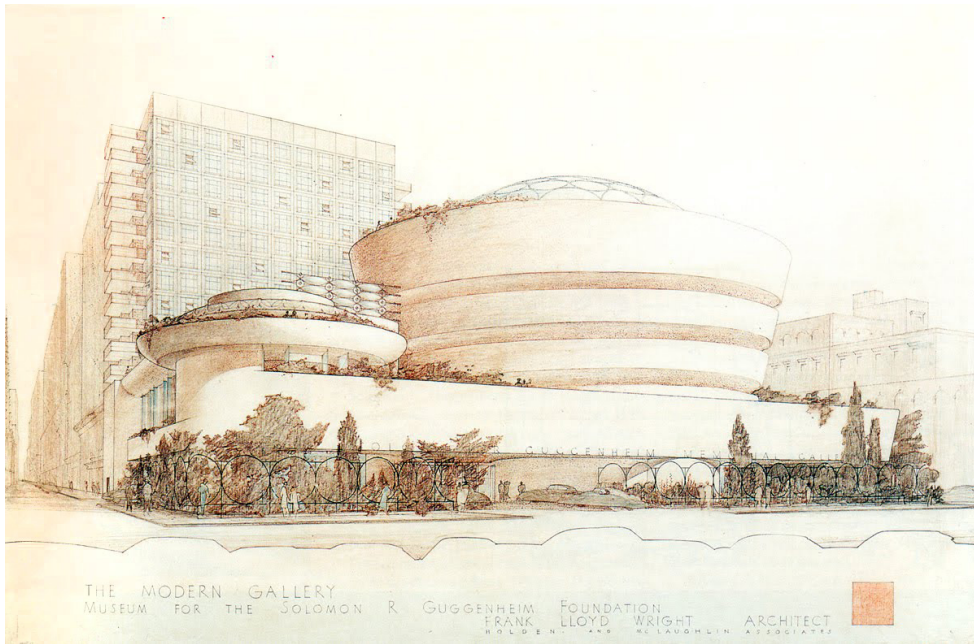

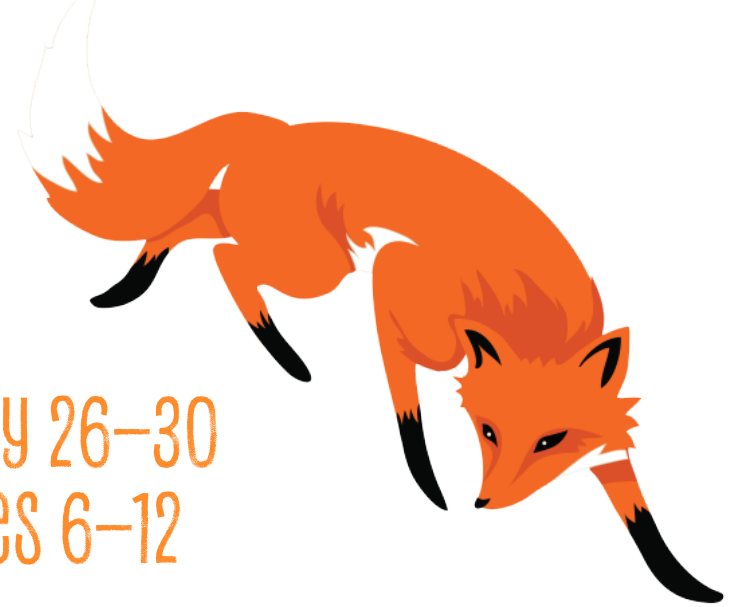


SESSION 10
