2025 Gulf Brew Artist FAQ

1. What is Gulf Brew?

a. Gulf Brew is Acadian's largest beer festival and a major annual fundraiser for the Acadiana Center for the Arts (ACA). The event features beer tastings, food, music- and a curated craft marketplace organized by the Louisiana Crafts Guild.

2. When and where is the event?

- a. Saturday, October 18th, 2025
- b. 1:00-5:00 PM
- c. Jefferson Street in Downtown Lafayette

3. How much is it to participate as a craft vender?

- a. \$50 for Louisiana Crafts Guild Members
- b. \$75 for non-members
- c. Non-members also pay a \$30 Jury Fee- This helps us maintain a balanced and high-quality craft market.

4. What do I get with my booth fee?

- a. 10X10 outdoor booth space
- b. Social media promotion (If accepted before deadline)
- c. One beverage voucher: Beer, DD/Mock-tail or Opt-out
- d. Prime placement alongside one of Lafayette biggest crowds

5. What's the schedule for artist on event day?

- a. 9:00 AM: Check-in begins
- b. 12:00 PM: All vehicles must be off Jefferson Street
- c. 12:30 PM: Booths must be fully set up and ready
- d. 1:00-5:00 PM: Event Hours

6. Where do I unload and park?

a. All artist will unload directly at their booth location on Jefferson Street. Once unloaded, vehicles must be moved to First Horizon Bank Parking Lot designated for artist parking. Final check-in booth location will be provided closer to the event.

7. Can I bring a trailer?

a. Trailers are not preferred, as of now we do not have a designated space to park them, and will have to make special accommodations.

8. What type of work is accepted?

a. This is a handmade-only event. No mass-produced or resale items. All work must be original and created by the applying artist.

9. When will I hear back after applying?

a. You'll recieve an email confirming your acceptance, along with payment instructions. Payments must by receive by September 28th to secure your spot.
